



Nestled between Lake Geneva and the Alps, the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace has enchanted visitors for over a century with its Belle Époque architecture, 236 rooms and suites, and an impeccable hotel reputation that dates back to its foundation in 1906.

Presiding over the Avenue Claude Nobs and the lakeside promenade, its location is exceptional. It allows guests to enjoy all the famous tourist sites of the region (the vineyards of Lavaux, the Château de Chillon, Glacier 3000 with its famous "Peak Walk" and the Charlie Chaplin Museum) and events that punctuate the seasons such as the legendary Montreux Jazz Festival in summer and the Montreux Christmas Market in winter.

The 6 restaurants and bars of the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace make it a must-see gastronomic destination. The Fairmont Spa, a true haven of peace, embodies the tranquility and purity of the Swiss Alps on more than 2'000 m2 drenched in light. With its 15 meeting and conference rooms, it is the largest five-star hotel on the Swiss Riviera.

A mythical palace



Since its inauguration in March 1906, The Fairmont Le Montreux Palace has embodied elegance and cozy luxury. Also known as the "Pearl of the Swiss Riviera", this jewel of the Belle Époque stands majestically on the shores of Lake Geneva, offering a breathtaking view of the lake and the Alps. Its unique atmosphere, both intimate and sparkling, was immediately appreciated by celebrities from all over the world, artists, crowned heads and writers, among them the writer Vladimir Nabokov, who lived here for more than 15 years, or Freddy Mercury, Quincy Jones, Prince, the Deep Purple group and many others who had their way there. If these personalities contributed to write the myth in the pages of the history of the establishment, the Montreux Palace never remained frozen in the past.

Although more than a century has passed, preserving the character of the hotel has always been a priority. The spirit of the founder of the Montreux Palace, Alexandre Emery, and the architect Eugène Jost are still present. Today, the palace offers both the luxurious charm of its Belle Époque decor and the comfort and technology that meet the highest standards of contemporary luxury hotels.

Montreux or the "Dolce Riviera"

Mountains, music and the magic – they all come together in beautiful harmony in Montreux and its postcard landscape. Surrounded by the high Alpine peaks and situated on the shores of the shimmering waters of Lake Geneva, Montreux has been delighting visitors for over a century with an inimitable blend of natural splendor, elegance and leisure. And in the heart of it all, lies the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace, a jewel of Belle Époque architecture, ideally located.

In Montreux, the natural splendor of the surrounding Alps blends with the charm of a human-scale town where it feels good to live all year round. It offers a multitude of outdoor and cultural activities depending on the seasons. The climax of the festivities takes place every year for two weeks in July with the internationally renowned Montreux Jazz Festival. The luxury and cozy atmosphere of the hotel gives way to a certain effervescence. Impossible to name all the artists who have been received at the palace, from Miles Davis to the most famous Brazilian singers, including Ray Charles, Al Jarreau, Carlos Santana and so many others.

Far from the hustle and bustle of a big city, the distances between the various activities offered in Montreux and the region are very short. It is therefore easy to move from one activity to another in complete tranquility: museums, art galleries, typical tourist sites, walks to explore the rich history of the Swiss Riviera, and shopping.



Guest Rooms & Suites

Combining tradition and elegance, the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace offers 236 rooms and suites in a classic European style, harmoniously blended with contemporary elements. Featuring luxurious furnishings and sumptuous bedding, the rooms and suites meet the requirements of the most discerning travelers. From the balconies and terraces, you can gaze out over the azure waters of Lake Geneva.

Among the hotel's exceptional suites is the **Presidential Suite**. With a total surface area of 139 m2, it can be connected to a communicating room with private bathroom for a total space of 178 m2. It marvels by its magnificent views of Lake Geneva and the Alps. The suite elegantly reflects the history and values of the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace. A reference to the Belle Époque. It includes a large living room, a large bedroom with a dressing room and a second communicating bedroom, both with large windows overlooking the lake. The generously sized bathroom is an ode to relaxation.


Completely renovated in 2020, the new Penthouse Suite is located on the 7th floor of the wing adjoining the main building of the palace formerly known as the Swan Hotel. 160 m2 of emotion and history, luxury and elegance. This Suite is the expression of "timeless chic" that combines noble materials and soothing colors with Mediterranean accents. It offers three spacious bedrooms including a master suite with a separate dressing room, a generous living room with fireplace opening onto a lounge and a fully equipped kitchen. From its splendid terrace of 12 m2, the 360° view on Lake Geneva and the Alps is breathtaking. Worthy of an artist's canvas, it gives the impression of sailing on the waves of the lake.

Some suites pay tribute with great affection to artists / writers who have contributed to making Montreux a world-famous city. Vladimir Nabokov, Freddie Mercury, Quincy Jones are just a few figures whose lives and careers are inextricably linked to the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace. Music lovers might opt for the "Freddie Mercury Suite" or the "Quincy Jones Suite", where he has stayed many times during the Montreux Jazz Festival.









For Freddy Mercury, Montreux was more than just the venue for the famous Montreux Jazz Festival. The artist recorded "Jazz", "Hot Space" and "A Kind of Magic" there between 1978 and 1985. During those productive days, he stayed several times at the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace. Michael Jackson, meanwhile, moved into the hotel's Tower Suite for two weeks while recording a new song in the Mountain Studios in 1997.

Every guest, famous or anonymous, will forever remember the exceptional view of Lake Geneva admired from their balcony!

A gourmet destination

Gastronomy is another reason to visit the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace! To seduce every taste, the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace offers a choice of 6 venues bringing together local and world flavors, as well as a 24-hour room service.

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Excellent breakfast buffets served daily with a wide variety of international and local breakfast classics while enjoying the beautiful view over Lake Geneva and the Alps. Each Sunday, hotel guests and external guests can enjoy the Sunday Brunch with delicious breakfast dishes among classics and themed stations, not mentioning the lavish dessert buffet. The Kids Corner offering a multitude of activities for children aged 4 to 12 years old is open during school vacations and for the Sunday Brunch.

MONTREUX JAZZ CAFÉ



Gourmets will appreciate its generous cuisine combined with a selection of the region's best wines and irresistibly named aperitifs. Decorated with souvenirs and objects that belonged to Claude Nobs, founder of the Montreux Jazz Festival, it is the ideal place to share an informal moment while being lulled by the festival's unique atmosphere.

THE LOUNGE BAR

It feels like home in the Lounge. Its cozy lounge atmosphere lends itself to an early morning coffee, a light lunch, a glass of champagne or even a late evening snack. Around the fireplace, conversation is easily engaged between local guests and visitors from all over the world.

MP'S BAR & GRILL

FUNKY CLAUDE'S BAR

Formerly known as Harry's Bar, the Funky Claude's Bar now pays tribute to Claude Nobs, founder of the Montreux Jazz Festival. Fiery jam sessions have been held there, which makes this bar so emblematic.

Renovated in 2021, the Fairmont Spa (formerly known as the Willow Stream Spa) has become a new oasis of relaxation, highlighting the natural elements that nourish the very essence of its identity and the treatments it provides, while bringing in new features and state-of-the-art infrastructure. It covers more than 2,000 square meters bathed in light thanks to its large windows facing the lake. The facilities include an indoor and outdoor swimming pool, seven treatment rooms, a mixed zone with sauna, infrared beds, relaxation area, wellness areas with jacuzzi, hammam, and tropical shower. A true haven of peace that embodies the tranquility and purity of the Swiss Alps. The wellness and relaxation treatments also contribute greatly to the reputation of the place. The high ceilings and Belle Époque splendor of the Congress Hall, or the sparkling chandeliers and sumptuous decor of the Salle des Fêtes will be the perfect setting for an exceptional event. The team dedicated to the organization of events, whether it is a large fairy tale wedding, a gala evening, private meetings or intimate family gatherings, creates unforgettable emotions.



After a century spent welcoming the greats of this world, our event teams have refined their mastery of all the details required for an exceptional wedding: floral combinations whose colors perfectly enhance the wedding gown, cutlery and a sumptuous reception decor, a set piece that is as tasty as it is magnificent. This is why a personal wedding planner is offered to the future bride and groom as well as a team of experts who will take care of all the details. The ultimate romance? The exchange of vows in the hotel's gardens with an incomparable view of Lake Geneva and the Alps, with the hotel itself serving as the setting for this unique moment.

The romantic setting of the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace is often chosen for extraordinary weddings. An <u>article in the magazine Bilan of July 29, 2018</u> recounts one of them: "Two elephants carved into a bush of pink flowers, dream creatures draped in pearl-covered saris, ribbons of multicolored flowers, an altar erected facing Lake Geneva to welcome the bride and groom... Nothing was too beautiful or too expensive in mid-June to celebrate the union of the granddaughter of the founder of a consortium of luxury brands based in Dubai. The groom's parents - Indian exporters based in London - had also invited hundreds of their friends, including some of the sub-continent's biggest fortunes.

Four days of celebration transformed the peaceful town of Montreux into the backdrop for the Thousand and One Nights. But for Michael Smithuis, director of the Fairmont chain's palace, the organization was far from moonlight: "We had to mobilize all our energies. But our strength is that we can organize each event in a different part of the hotel: the lobby, the large restaurant, the garden, the terrace, the gala room, etc. We have to be able to organize each event in a different part of the hotel. You need variety. The Indian guests arrived with their teams of decorators, their staff and about ten cooks from the Fairmont Hotel in Jaïpur, who worked with our chefs. This is the fourth year that we have hosted an Indian wedding and its 400 to 500 guests".

Committed to the environment

To promote sustainable solutions, Fairmont Le Montreux Palace teams up with its employees, involves its customers, innovates with its partners and works with local communities. In recent years, priorities have been set to develop ecoresponsible practices.

An original air conditioning system

The Fairmont Le Montreux Palace uses an original air-conditioning system that works with lake water. Compared to a standard air conditioning system, pumping lake water saves more than 60% of the annual electricity consumption (340'000 kWh/year). The cold water from Lake Geneva is collected at a depth of about 80 m through a pipe about 310 meters long and is redistributed to the air conditioning systems of the rooms and then released back into the lake, as clear and clean as it was.

SapoCycle Initiative

SapoCycle is a non-profit association that collects used soaps from European hotels, re-processes them and redistributes them in recycled form to families in need to improve children's health conditions. Disabled people are employed to recycle the soaps, allowing them to work in a stable environment. In 2018, we collected 99.8 kg of soap! Since the beginning of our involvement in this initiative, on October 1, 2015, to date, we have collected more than 343.8 kg!

BeeHomes Initiative

Fairmont Le Montreux Palace has installed two bee houses with two bee colonies in its gardens to promote biodiversity and support the local pollination process. The second step will be the installation of beehives. We also buy local honey which is used in our restaurants and offered at the breakfast buffet.

Plastic Free Initiative

Fairmont Le Montreux Palace has removed all plastic items from the daily operations of the F&B department (straws, cocktail sticks, plastic cups, coffee mugs to go, etc.). These items have been replaced in order to reduce our impact on the environment and offer our guests more environmentally friendly options, while maintaining the 5-star service that defines us.

Too good to go Initiative

Every year, one third of all food produced in the world is thrown away. Fairmont Le Montreux Palace is proud to participate in the Too Good To Go initiative to fight food waste in our restaurants. The application allows you to buy at reduced prices dishes of the day made by Fairmont Le Montreux Palace chefs at the Montreux Jazz Café that were not sold the same day, while taking action to preserve our planet.





Michael Smithus began his career at Intercontinental Hotels in London where he held various positions in the Food & Beverage department. He then moved into Front Office positions as Night Manager and Assistant Manager. After gaining experience in London, he took on a new challenge in the Sultanate of Oman and became Deputy Director of the Front Office at the famous Al Bustan Palace Hotel. He held this position for two years, gaining valuable management knowledge.

His return to Europe followed a transfer as Front Office Manager to the Stuttgart InterContinental Hotel in Germany. In order to continue his career, Michael Smithuis felt the need to familiarize himself with other operational practices. In 1996, he had the opportunity to join the Mandarin Oriental Hotel Group. He moved to Indonesia as Executive Assistant Manager in Jakarta.

In 1998, a new opportunity presented itself: to join Raffles Hotels and Resorts and help rebrand the famous Hotel Vier Jahreszeiten in Hamburg, Germany. This is followed by a position as General Manager at the head office in Singapore.

After an exciting period in Asia, Michael Smithuis returns to his home country, the Netherlands, where he runs Swissôtel in Amsterdam for one year.

In 2003, he was offered a new opportunity in Montreux, Switzerland, where he was appointed Managing Director of the famous Fairmont Le

Montreux Palace. Since 2018, he has taken on the role of Regional Vice President in addition to his current position as Managing Director of the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace, overseeing other luxury establishments of the Accor Group in Europe with the aim of bringing them the benefit of his 33 years of experience in the luxury segment.

"Being Managing Director of the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace involves a lot of responsibility and work with our teams, but it is also an honor and a pleasure to work with our staff throughout the year. As Director, my main interest is the sustainability of the hotel while respecting the history of this prestigious establishment that has made its reputation for more than a century. Of course, we want to continue to be among the best hotels in Europe and the world with the quality service and attention to detail that characterizes us. "explains Michael Smithuis.
