Taste of Valais!

Valais enjoys above-average amounts of sunshine and boasts magnificent natural landscapes: ideal for kicking back and relaxing. Thanks to the ideal conditions, Valais produces a wide variety of delicious natural produce. With its 4,700 hectares of vineyards, Valais is the leading winemaking region in Switzerland and has the most AOP- and IGP-labelled products in the country. Raclette, air-dried beef, and rye bread are among the local specialities that foodies seek out and chefs love to use in their creations. 79 gourmet restaurants in Valais have 1109 Gault&Millau points and 10 Michelin stars between them. 67 restaurants have been awarded the «Saveurs du Valais» (Flavours of Valais) label, indicating that they source their ingredients from local farmers and winemakers and serve mainly Valais specialties.

Robust wines with mineral notes, cheeses with floral undertones, vitamin-rich fruit and vegetables, characterful salted meats and rare spices - Valais is home to a large number of local specialties that taste simply wonderful. From the flatlands of the Rhone valley to the mountain pastures, not forgetting the sun-kissed orchards, the canton is a garden of delights where knowhow passed down through the generations combines with daring culinary creations to create sheer joy for the taste buds. Intensely flavoured fruits, rare spices, golden cereals, and brandies with fine aromas are the result of thousands of hours of sunshine, transforming Valais into a garden full of delicious delights. Skills and knowledge handed down from generation to generation have allowed nature in this mountainous part of the country to be tamed, resulting in produce of the highest quality. Diversity, flavour, character, authenticity and passion - local products from Valais invite you on a journey of discovery through this unique landscape.

The Valais brand is a mark of recognition of the origin and quality of products which are emblematic of the Canton of Valais. The criteria attributed to this brand are: products must originate from the Valais, adherence to the specifications and the commitment of the enterprise through the signature of a charter, respect for the values of the brand and the principles of sustainable development.

This welcoming region in the south of Switzerland, framed by famous Alpine peaks, is home to countless prized gastronomic treasures and traditions. If just one could be mentioned it would be Raclette cheese, served spontaneously at village festivities and family gatherings. Valais is also one of the Swiss regions with the greatest number of gastronomic restaurants per head of population. For the year 2024, Gault&Millau lists 79 restaurants.

At the «Saveurs du Valais» (Flavours of Valais) restaurants, you can try seasonal local food and enjoy Valais specialties made from traditional recipes. Fancy a traditional raclette, an «assiette valaisanne» (a platter of local foods) or some asparagus? At restaurants bearing the «Saveurs du Valais» label, you can try Valais specialties and enjoy Valais wines. Certainly, there are other dishes to discover as well, depending on the valley and region. Explore an amazing range of delicious cheese and meat specialties and treat yourself to a dessert featuring Valais apricots and Williams pears in season. To round off your meal, you can choose from two Valais AOP spirits: Abricotine and Valais pear brandy.

Wine-growing and cultural events both have a big importance in this region.

Thanks to its central position, Sierre is also an ideal starting point for lots of excursions. Over 640 selected Grand Crus from more than 102 vineyards are ready for winetasting in the Oenotheque at the Château de Villa.

The Meyer-Haus in Sierre and the Zumofen-Haus in the wine village Salgesch make up together the Wine and Vineyard Museum and are linked by a 6 km long themed walk. www.sierre.ch

Discover traces of history in Leuk: the Roman fireplace and the medieval Bishops palace bear witness to Leuk's great past. Susten is the gateway to the Pfynwald Nature Reserve, a forest that is the largest contiguous pine forest in central Europe. Its variety of habitats never fails to impress the visitor. 



O9:30 Time at disposal to visit the park. The Pfyn-Finges Regional Nature Park stretches from 500 to 4,100 metres above sea level in central Valais between Gampel and Sierre. Nowhere else in the Alpine arc are there so many imposing, world-famous four-thousand-metre peaks as in Valais. The nature park takes its name from the Pfynwald conservation area. Finges is the French translation of Pfyn. Its uniqueness lies in its natural potential: its USPs are Pfynwald, geology (Illgraben, wild Rhone), wine (80 wineries in the park perimeter), ornithology (rarest bird species) and bilingualism (language

border)
