## 150 years Mount Rigi Railways

Europe's first ever cogwheel railway will be 150 years old in 2021. This historic milestone in Swiss railway and tourism history is being commemorated and celebrated with an attractive programme of events throughout the year. The big anniversary weekend – with, as highlight, a vintage vehicle parade – is on 21-24 May 2021.

# 200 years Lion Monument

To mark the 200th anniversary on 10 August 2021, exhibitions, performances, events and publications have been dedicated to the history of the Lion Monument since 2017. The "dying lion" in the centre of Lucerne commemorates the Swiss Guards massacred on 10 August 1792 when revolutionaries stormed the Tuileries Palace in Paris during the French Revolution.

#### **Renovation Glacier Garden**

The Glacier Garden Lucerne is currently undergoing extensive renovation and expansion. A major highlight is planned for the summer of 2021: the opening of the rock visitor experience and the Sommerau expansion. The Schweizerhaus historical residence complete with a new bistro and museum shop opened in September 2020.

Able to accommodate approx. 420 persons seated or 800 standing, the impressive Kursaal is ideal for concerts, wedding receptions, banquets and large gatherings.

# **Opening Hotel Palace Engelberg**

The first 5-star hotel in Engelberg is scheduled to open in early summer 2021: The Hotel Palace Engelberg will offer 129 stylish guest rooms and suites, a first-class restaurant and a bar. The new building is being skilfully integrated into the existing fabric dating from 1904, resulting in a thought-through combination of old-time nostalgia and modern zeitgeist.






#### Renovation paddle steamer «Stadt Luzern»
