E-mountain bike tour from hut to hut (picture E MTB)

Three days of riding fun, two mountain huts to stay in: The new e-bike hut tour leads through the entire bike destination Davos Klosters. Shred single trails, experience a good uphill flow and spend the night in the rustic Vereina and Dürrboden mountain inns in the Dischma Valley. With the e-mountain bike, you can master longer distances and more metres in altitude. In addition to 130 kilometres of biking fun, the view on the Hüreli, the idyllic valleys, a picnic at the Ravais lakes and, at the end, a ride on the nostalgic train back to Davos are all enticing.

Eight days, three countries and always in teams of two: The Dynafit Transalpine Run is a stage race in which the participants cross the Alps. With a route length of 200 to 300 km and around 15,000 metres of altitude difference, the run is one of the most ambitious mountain runs in Europe.
