Reka invests CHF 7.5 million in the Hasliberg holiday village

The Reka Hasliberg holiday village is one of the Reka Swiss Travel Fund's most popular holiday resorts. Now it is being renovated in stages. Already, 24 apartments in three of the holiday villas have been renovated. The apartments in the other three holiday villas will be renovated in November before the start of the 2023/24 winter season. The holiday village was originally built in 1993. The resort offers 60 spacious apartments spread over six holiday villas. The resort also includes the "Haus des Gastes", a small library, an indoor swimming pool, a sauna, and a massage practice. The holiday village is located in the immediate vicinity of the Wasserwendi-Käserstatt mountain railway.

Roofing of curling fields at the Alpine Sports Centre Mürren

The Alpine Sports Centre Mürren is investing in the roofing of its infrastructure. In summer 2020, the small ice rink adjacent to the sports hall got a new roof at a cost of CHF 1.4 million. By doing so, the available space for sports and events has been expanded. In winter, a total of three curling fields can now be offered, which are protected from the weather. The large ice rink with an additional six curling rinks remains an outdoor experience. In addition, there is also a spa with saunas, a steam bath, indoor massage pool and outdoor whirlpool, indoor swimming pool, and much more on offer here.

Snowshoe tour with meditative exercises on the Rigi

Experience the winter flair of the Weggis Vitznau Rigi region in an entirely new way. "The Innerwalk Project — Winter Version" combines (snowshoe) hiking to places of power with mindfulness practices from yoga, ecstatic dance, sound healing and guided meditation. New children's snow sports area in Hüttenberg

There is a new children's snow sports area in Hüttenberg for families and children to enjoy: "Kinderland Hüttenberg". A few initiators, including the Braunwald Ski School, have conceptualised the Hüttenberg area as a family meeting place. The focus is on Kinderland Hüttenberg, which is available to all guests as an additional practice area (not just guests of the ski school). Small children in particular can practise here. The area is equipped with two rope lifts, course and slalom elements, many training aids and small jumps. This makes practising especially fun. The surroundings are also suitably set up: There is the new Snowli Grill snack bar right next door, where guests can quickly satisfy their hunger and quench their thirst. There are also new family-friendly sanitary facilities.
