The viewing platform, allowing you to savor the crisp embrace of winter on your face while delighting in vistas that encompass 38 towering peaks exceeding four thousand meters and 14 glaciers spanning the French, Italian, and Swiss Alps. A visit to the glacier palace enables you to immerse yourself in the timeless world of ice and gain deeper insights into the mesmerizing mountain world of Zermatt at the Cinema Lounge. Should you seek respite from the wintry chill, indulge in a comforting cup of hot chocolate at the Peak restaurant.

By the way, from Christmas onwards the cable car connection Zermatt (CH) - Cervinia (IT), called the Matterhorn Alpine Crossing, will also be open for winter visitors. Enjoy the charming cable car journey through the snow-covered winter landscape of the high alpine mountains.

Whether you are a beginner or an expert, the Matterhorn Ski Paradise offers 360 kilometres of perfectly groomed slopes in winter. With your skis or on your snowboard, you can experience the winter a very Swiss way.

<u>How to travel: Gornergrat Railway - Glacier Express - train shuttle</u>

Gornergrat Railway – 125 years of fascination. Within 35 minutes the cogwheel train takes guests from the station in Zermatt all year round up to the viewpoint at 3'135 m. a.s.l.. From there they have a stunning view towards 29 peaks higher than 4000m including the iconic Matterhorn. In winter guests can enjoy many different activities: there are snowy, well-prepared hiking paths or snowshoe tours in undisturbed nature. After that, guests can enjoy a fortifying snack on one of the many sunny terraces or even have an entire 'gourmet' day with the Gourmet Ticket. For the more adventurous there is the speedy descents on the highest sledding run in the Alps. Gornergrat Railway is, of course, part of the skiing area of Zermatt with more than 360 km of slopes.

New in 2023 is the NostalChic Class: an exciting, guided full day experience including drinks and food on board of a refurbished old Gornergrat Railway carriage.

As Zermatt is a car free mountain resort, to get there you can either use one of the most famous panoramic trains – the Glacier Express. During the 8 h train ride from St. Moritz to Zermatt guests can enjoy an everchanging scenery with highlights like the Landwasser viaduct or the Oberalppass (2000m a.s.l.). This is especially during winter season an exceptional experience. For those arriving by coach or car parking is available in Täsch. A train shuttle takes guests every 20 in a short train ride right into the centre of Zermatt.
