

The waiting has come to an end: Switzerland is welcoming fully vaccinated travellers from the UK since 19th July. There is no quarantine required anymore on the way back into the UK, two Covid tests however remain in place. Further, some airlines might have different rules when it comes to PCR tests that are needed in order to board the plane and it's advisable to check these details well in advance.
