More flexibility and choice for travelers

Edelweiss to increase its non-stop service from Tampa to Zurich to three weekly flights

Edelweiss, Switzerland's leading leisure airline, has announced to increase its non-stop flights between Tampa and Zurich from two to three weekly frequencies. Flights will operate each Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

"This is an effect of our success that we have seen on the route since its start", said Alain Chisari, Edelweiss Chief Commercial Officer. The flights will be operated by an Airbus A330 from Edelweiss. In June 2014, Edelweiss long-haul aircraft underwent refurbishing to significantly improve the cabin. Edelweiss Business Class is now equipped with fully lie-flat seats and a new in-flight entertainment system including sixteen inch screens. Furthermore, Edelweiss has introduced Economy Max, which offers passengers fifteen centimeters more legroom and many other amenities to ensure a comfortable flight. Edelweiss Economy Class also received a makeover with new seats and a new in-flight entertainment system that includes touch screens.
