In the winter of 2014/2015, Switzerland will be celebrating 150 years of winter tourism. As the birthplace of winter tourism, St. Moritz is set to take center stage.

Also new as of 2015 are the periods of validity of the Swiss Travel Pass (3, 4, 8 and 15 consecutive days). Travelers under the age of 26 will receive a 15% reduction off the regular price of the Pass.
