#### Matterhorn: Climbed for 150 Years

There are many activities planned, including a musical performance of the Matterhorn Story in Open Air Theatre, depicting the successful ascent. #### "Top of Europe Ice Magic" Interlaken

From mid-December till February the center of Interlaken will be transformed into a winter wonderland. #### Stand-Xpress: Adelboden-Lenk Brings People Together

The first 10-person gondola lift in the Bernese Oberland opened for the winter season. Snow sports enthusiasts, hikers and sunbathers can appreciate this new way of transport with its 89 spacious cabins, leather seats and panoramic windows. Within 10 minutes, the gondolas take them up the 1,000m (3,300ft) climb to the Metschstand at 2,100m (6,900ft), a unique viewing point in the valley.
