The cable car ride to the Männlichen takes just 5 minutes from Wengen. Once on the mountain 7,300ft (2,230m) above sea level, set off on the "The Royal Path", a scenic trail to the summit. The 20-minute ascent with the mountain panorama in sight will make you feel like a king. On the throne-like summit, enjoy the view of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau as well as Lake Thun.
