Andermatt offers an unforgettable mountain experience with all the amenities of an innovative and easily accessible holiday destination. The mountain village in the Urseren Valley is a melting pot of languages and cultures. Centuries ago, streams of muleteers with their heavily laden pack animals stopped here on their way to and from northern Italy via the Gotthard Pass. At 1,444 metres above sea level, the picturesque mountain village is a paradise for snow sports enthusiasts. With more than 120 km of slopes and 22 installations, the SkiArena Andermatt-Sedrun is the largest ski area in Central Switzerland, extending to the summit of the Gemsstock (at almost 3,000 metres in altitude) as well as over the Schneehüenerstock and Oberalp Pass to Sedrun in the canton of Graubünden. Winter 2018/19 sees the opening of the final ski link connecting Andermatt with Sedrun. In summer, Andermatt is the ideal starting point for mountain hikes, climbing tours and rides in an open-top convertible over the Gotthard, Furka and Oberalp passes, while an attractive 18-hole, par-72 championship golf course awaits golfing devotees. With its five surrounding Alpine passes, Andermatt is also a paradise for road cycling and mountain biking aficionados.

The new Radisson Blu Reussen is the perfect “base camp” for tackling the variety of attractive winter and summer activities in this beautiful region.

Spacious rooms and apartments with a fantastic feel-good factor

The understated elegance of the 179 rooms, as well as of the 65 suites and apartments of the Gotthard Residences with their one, two or three bedrooms, is reminiscent of the Scandinavian furnishing style with its simple, linear design. The generous use of natural materials and fabrics increases the feel-good factor to create a warm ambience, while the rooms, suites and

apartments – which measure between 28 and 132 square metres – benefit from a range of amenities, including free Wi-Fi, LED TVs and 24-hour room service.

Representing a true oasis of contentment, the spacious and contemporary “uella” spa and gym with two saunas and a steam bath provides an inviting environment for guests to relax, as do the 13 well-being and health treatment rooms. The 25-metre indoor pool with separate children’s play pool boasts floor-to-ceiling windows, providing views of the Oberalp Valley and its mountains.

Cuisine majoring on regionality and freshness

Spun, the hotel’s restaurant, serves meticulously composed Swiss specialities and upscale Italian cuisine: the international kitchen team insists on regional, fresh ingredients. For larger events, the restaurant can provide a separate area for up to 60 diners.

With its dominant fireplace, the eye-catching Bärbar is just the place for a snack or light meal: available here are a selection of Alpine-inspired regional delicacies and international classics. Rounding out the culinary offer are an international cocktail menu, a large selection of craft beers and an exquisite wine selection. The open fire is also the perfect place to end an eventful day while on holiday.
