

# Travel regulations



- As of October 25, 2021, all people vaccinated outside of the EU (including tourists from the U.S. and Canada) are required to apply for the Swiss vaccination certificate to enter indoor venues.
  - Apply <u>HERE</u> for the Swiss COVID certificate / <u>HERE</u> for Geneva
  - Cost for conversion: CHF 30 per person (to be paid in advance).
  - Processing time can take up to 5 working days.

- To return to US and Canada a PCR COVID or rapid test is required (Testing sites MySwitzerland.com)





# Lugano Region

# O8.25 am Lakecruise

Start the day with a cruise on Lake Lugano: either make it a leisurely round trip or get off the boat at Morcote, the most beautiful village of Switzerland voted by the Swiss people in 2016. From this picturesque village walk up to Mount San Salvatore or take the bus back to the centre of Lugano.

#### 12.14 pm Via Nassa

Have a lunch break on Piazza Riforma then stroll along Via Nassa, the main shopping street of Lugano, which leaves nothing to be desired. Walk back along the lakefront and see the impressive historical buildings along the promenade.

# O6.11 pm Sunset at Mt. Brè

In Castagnola, take the funicular which stops directly on the top of Switzerlands sunniest mountain. Breathe in the fresh air and enjoy the view over the whole region and into parts of Italy. Have a delicious dinner while watching the sun go down.

#### O8.30 pm Concert at LAC

To conclude the day, visit an art exhibition at the LAC Lugano Arte and Cultura centre or enjoy a great concert in its beautiful hall directly on the lakefront. This new Arts Centre promises to become one of Switzerland's most important cultural institutions.

# O8.47 am Lakefront of Ascona

Take a seat on the famous Piazza directly on the Ascona lakeshore – the so-called "Dearl of Lake Maggiore". Sip a delicious cappuccino and admire the view of Lake Maggiore and the Brissago Islands.

#### O9.30 am Brissago Islands

Board a boat going to the Islands – the lowest point of Switzerland and a botanical paradise. The Mediterranean atmosphere, the view of the lake and the surrounding natural landscape gives visitors the chance to enjoy the restaurant's gastronomic specialties in a unique environment.

#### O3.28 pm Verzasca Valley

Ever wanted to feel like James Bond? The 220m (722 ft) bungee jump at the Verzasea Dam makes it possible. After this adrenalinerich experience relax on the shores of the Verzasea River under the double-arched bridge in Lavernezzo.

#### O8.12 pm Piazza Grande

Savour dinner on Piazza Grande and reflect on an exciting day of experiences while the sun slowly sets and the stars above this worldfamous square begin to sparkle. In summer this square hosts several festivals like the Locarno Festival and Moon&Stars.







# Lake Lugano, The Green Line


- The «Green Line» Ceresio is now 100% powered by green electric power
