Switzerland is fully open!

With effect from 2 May 2022, all remaining countries were removed from the SEM risk country list. This means that entry
into Switzerland from all countries in the world is again possible as it was before the pandemic.

Testing possibilities:

- On boarding and entry to Switzerland: **no PCR or rapid test required** for fully vaccinated guests.
- Testing sites at Zurich airport. Find more information <u>here</u>.
- Testing sites listed per canton can be found <u>here</u>.
- Masks:
 - Masks are not compulsory in Switzerland.


