The World's spokesperson

- Home to the European headquarters of the United Nations.
- Birthplace of the Red Cross in 1863 in Geneva.
- The Broken Chair, a monumental symbol against the use of landmines.
- Geneva hosts permanent missions of 179 States, 39 international organizations, 432 non-governmental organizations.
- Headquarters of ICRC (International Committee of the Red Cross), WHO (World Health Organisation), ITU (International Telecommunication Union), WTO (World Trade Organisation), ILO (International Labour Organisation), WIPO (World Intellectual Property Organisation), WMO (World Meteorological Organisation).

CERN Science Gateway

Since October 7th, 2023

New flagship project for science education and outreach

Through immersive exhibitions and hands-on educational activities, CERN Science Gateway will enable people of all ages and backgrounds to engage in the discoveries, the science and the technologies of CERN.

Highlights:

- Inspired by CERN's technical buildings and underground tunnels
- Five different spaces that will host exhibitions, hands-on laboratories, a large auditorium, a shop and a restaurant, all connected by a bridge 20ft / 6m above-ground.
- With more than 21K sq ft / 2 000 square metres of solar panels and surrounded by a forest of 400 trees, CERN Science Gateway will have a net zero carbon footprint.
- Science Gateway is designed by world-renowned Renzo <u>Piano Building Workshop</u> with support from <u>Brodbeck-Roulet</u> architectes associés.
