1 Old Town

The Old Town is one of Europe's best preserved, featuring medieval houses along its countless contorted and narrow streets. Many unique Zurich brands can be found here.



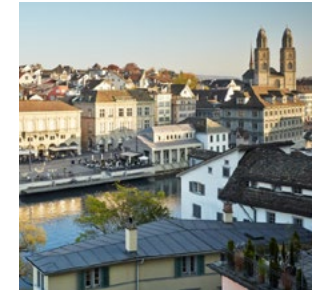
2 Fraumünster

Of all Zurich's church spires, the slender, blue spire of Fraumünster is the most graceful. The church holds a special treasure: three world-famous stained glass windows designed by Marc Chagall.



3 Grossmünster

The Grossmünster is one of Zurich's most famous landmarks. The accessible Karlsturm tower offers an extraordinary view of the Old Town, the Limmat river and the lake.



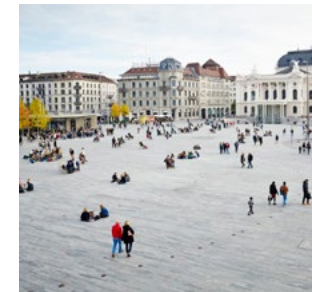
4 Lindenhof

A marvelous view of the River Limmat and the picturesque Old Town with its towers and roofs can be enjoyed right in the city center. This public square was the site of a Roman fort in the 4th century.



5 Bahnhofstrasse

The Bahnhofstrasse is one of the most beautiful shopping streets in Europe. Fashion, art and Zurich specialties attract shopping enthusiasts from all over the world.



6 Sechseläutenplatz

This is a place for relaxing between Lake Zurich, Bellevue and the Opera House. Several events are held here, such as the "Sechseläuten" (spring festival), Zurich Film Festival and many more.



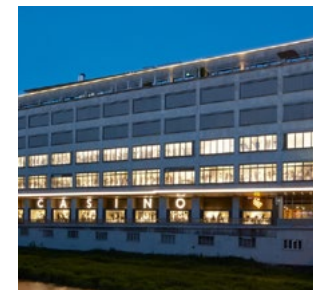
7 Bürkliplatz & Lakeside Promenade

Bürkliplatz is not only a boat dock, but also a marketplace, art area and event site with a spectacular view across Lake Zurich to the Alps.



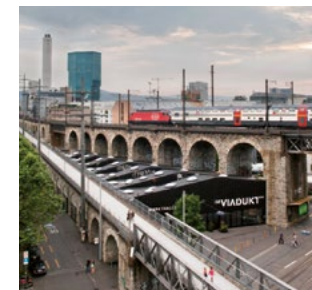
8 ETH Zurich

The terrace in front of the imposing building of the famous Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH) offers a fantastic view of the Old Town. ETH can be reached with the Polybahn funicular rail.



9 Casino Zurich

Switzerland's largest casino makes gamblers' hearts beat faster. Try your luck at Casino Zurich with over 280 gaming machines and 22 gaming tables.



10 Zürich-West

The former industrial area Zürich-West has been transformed into a hip district with design stores, contemporary art galleries, restaurants, bars and nightclubs.



11 Uetliberg

At 869 m (2,850 ft) above sea level, Uetliberg towers over the rooftops of Zurich. The mountain offers an impressive panoramic view of the city, the lake and the Alps.



12 Lindt Home of Chocolate

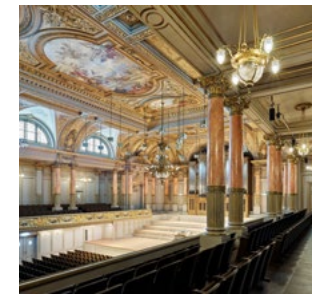
A unique experience: featuring an interactive museum, the world's largest Lindt store, a cafe and a chocolaterie for hosting workshops.

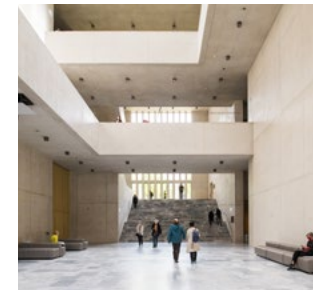

13 Zurich Opera House
The award-winning Zurich Opera House is the smallest of the world's large opera houses with approximately 1,100 seats. It features popular plays, renowned singers and ballets.



14 Tonhalle Zurich
The magnificent concert hall, built in 1895, has first-class acoustics. It is home to the Tonhalle Orchestra Zurich, which is regarded as one of the world's finest symphony orchestras.



15 Kunsthaus Zürich
The collection includes works by Munch, Picasso, Chagall and Giacometti. The major extension by architect David Chipperfield turned the museum into Switzerland's largest art museum.



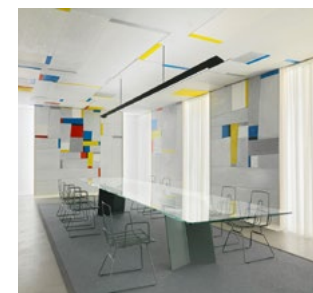
16 National Museum Zurich
The spectacular building next to the main station is reminiscent of a fairytale castle. It hosts the country's largest cultural and historical collection.



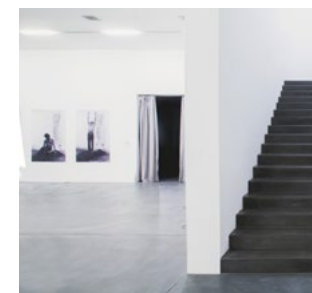
17 Museum für Gestaltung
The main building of this museum houses temporary exhibitions featuring design, visual communication and architecture.



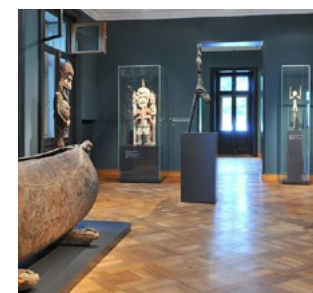
18 Pavillon Le Corbusier
This architectural delight on the banks of Lake Zurich is the last building designed by 20th-century architect Le Corbusier. The walk-through wonder is also a museum.



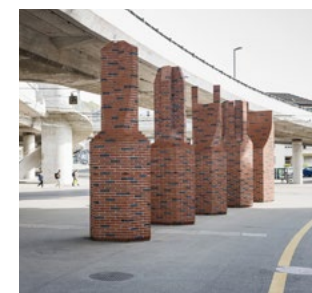
19 Haus Konstruktiv
The museum Haus Konstruktiv is located in one of the most distinctive landmarks of Zurich's industrial architecture, providing a space for concrete art.



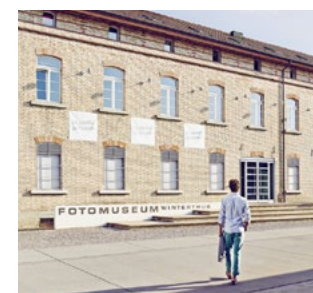
20 Löwenbräu Areal
This former brewery site is home to a cultural center with numerous art galleries and two art museums, the Migros Museum of Contemporary Art and the Kunsthalle Zurich.



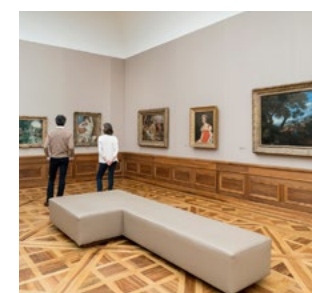
21 Museum Rietberg
Surrounded by a beautiful park, the Museum presents a unique collection of non-European art. It ranges from African sculptures to Buddhist art from Asia.

22 Fotomuseum, Winterthur

One of the most distinguished former private art collections in Europe is housed in Oskar Reinhart's former villa. It's surrounded by an idyllic architectonic garden.

26 Kronenhalle
One of the most iconic spots in Zurich is Kronenhalle at Bellevue, where you can enjoy "Zürcher Geschnetzeltes" surrounded by original Picasso, Mirò and Matisse paintings.



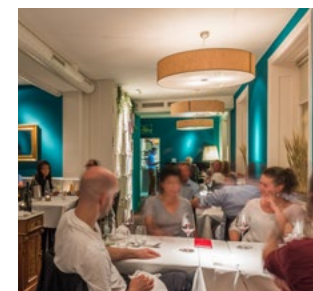
27 Marktküche
Popular not just among vegans: the Marktküche in Zurich's Kreis 4 quarter offers all connoisseurs appetizing dishes that leave nothing to be desired.



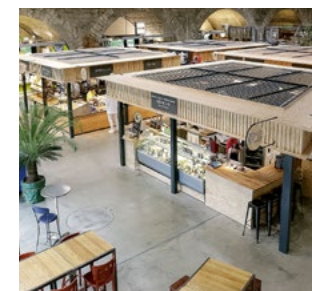
28 Haus Hiltl
The first vegetarian restaurant in the world, Hiltl has been at the heart of Zurich since 1898. Since its opening, even meat-lovers can't get enough of what is offered at the buffet.



29 Zunfthaus zur Waag
The Zunfthaus at Münsterhof is a 17th-century restaurant, known for its upscale fine dining. The terrace in the heart of Zurich's Old Town is the ideal place to relax.



30 Rechberg 1837
The Rechberg only serves up what the year 1837 had to offer in terms of cuisine: old and forgotten vegetable varieties and meat from the local farm.



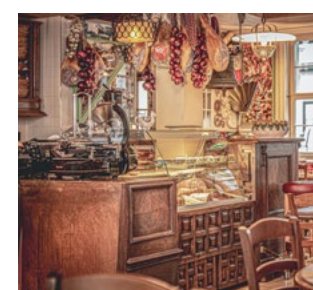
31 Viadukt Markthalle
Farmers, bakers, and butchers from the region offer their fresh products in this special ambience under the railway viaduct. Ask the traders; they are happy to advise you.



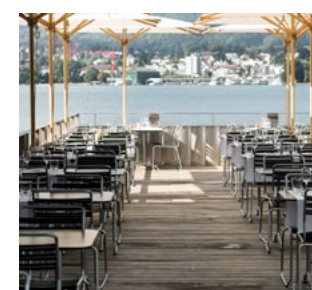
32 Igniv

33 LUX Restaurant & Bar
Housed in the renovated Zurich Convention Center and the world famous Tonhalle concert hall, the restaurant shows off its international flair and a spectacular lake view.



34 Trattoria Sempre
The trattoria brings mouthwatering Italian specialties to Zurich, just as guests know them from their vacation in Italy. Everything is "fatto in casa" – that is, homemade.



35 Fischerstube
With a kiosk, garden, jetty, lounge, fisherman's hut and lakeside terrace, the Fischerstube is embedded in a little village all of its own. Enjoy fresh fish from the lake and a priceless view of the Alps.

Summer

36 Flussbad Unterer Letten

At Zurich's oldest riverside swimming spot, confident swimmers can take the plunge into the Limmat river and float downstream.



38 Barfussbar

A women-only swimming pool by day, the timber-decked, barefoot bar known as Barfussbar is open for everyone at night. Shoes stay outside, as the name suggests.



40 Fischers Fritz

Surrounded by Mediterranean vibes and right on the banks of the lake, guests enjoy freshly caught fish straight out of Lake Zurich or tasty cotton candy for dessert.



42 Zürcher Theater Spektakel

The annual festival in Aug/Sep on the banks of Lake Zurich is a must for theater fans and culture vultures. The performances and street artists are popular with all walks of life.



44 Lake Zurich Navigation

What would Zurich be without its lake? Everyone who comes to Zurich needs to go on a boat cruise with the Lake Zurich Navigation Company.



46 Stand-Up Paddle

Float through the city on a stand-up paddle or take a course on Lake Zurich. Either way, a stand-up paddle board excursion is the perfect option for water-lovers.



37 Seebad Enge

The lakeside swimming spot Enge has both ladies-only and mixed swimming areas. Here, you can enjoy Alpine views, a sauna, yoga classes and SUP lessons.



39 Frau Gerolds Garten

There's always something going on at this urban garden near Hardbrücke. It's a popular place to meet over a meal or a drink, or to shop in the various boutiques nearby.



41 Restaurant & Bar Alex

At the design hotel Alex Lake Zurich, the restaurant offers its guests Mediterranean and Swiss dishes. Its beautiful terrace is located right on the water.



43 Zürich Openair

Located between Zurich Airport and the city center, the Zürich Openair festival caters to a wide urban audience with its rock, pop and electronic beats. It takes place in August.



45 Boat Hire

You can also discover Lake Zurich by renting a boat in the city center from boat rental "Lago" or "Enge". Whether you've got a skipper or you're the captain of your own ship – it's full speed ahead!



47 E-Bike

Whether solo or on a guided tour, e-bikes are the perfect way to discover all that Zurich has to offer in a short space of time. They can be booked at Zürich Tourism.

Just a stone's throw from Zurich Main Station, visitors to this museum are immersed in a world of optical and sensory illusions.



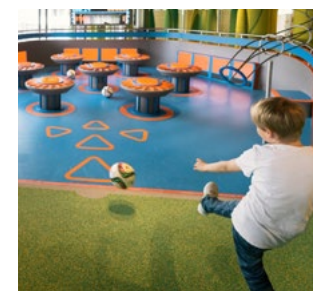
52 Technorama, Winterthur
At the only science center in Switzerland, you delve into natural and technological phenomena with all your senses. Thirty outdoor attractions await you in the new park.



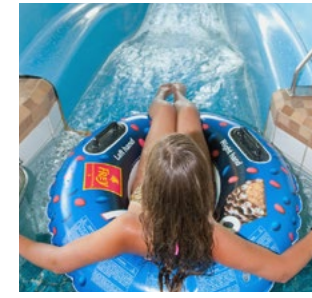
54 Atzmännig, Goldingen

58 FIFA Museum, Zurich
Spread over three floors, the museum examines all aspects of soccer in an interactive world, illustrating how, across the globe, the game stirs people's emotions.



49 Alpamare, Pfäffikon (SZ)
Alpamare is Europe's largest indoor water park, offering everything from thrilling slides to soothing thermal springs, saunas, a solarium and a special children's pool.



51 Jucker Farm, Seegräben & Jona
Adventures for adults and children at Jucker Farm in Seegräben and Jona. There's a straw paradise for young guests as well as a car-free atmosphere and a natural playground.



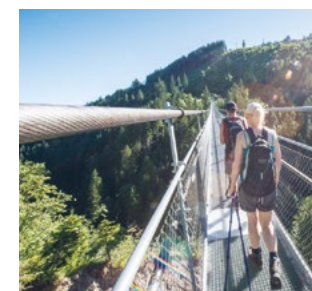
53 Höllgrotten, Baar
Formed by calciferous springs, Baar's "Höllgrotten" stalactite caves were discovered while mining for tuff rock at the end of the 19th century.



55 Knies Kinderzoo, Rapperswil
This children's zoo belongs to Switzerland's famous Knie Circus, and is a popular meeting place for animal-lovers of all ages.



57 Zurich Airport – Observation Deck B
Observation deck B offers a host of world innovations that give you an exciting glimpse into the complex interplay that takes place at Zurich Airport.



59 Sattel-Hochstuckli
The area known for its 374 m (1,227 ft) long hanging bridge, the "Raiffeisen Skywalk", is an ideal family excursion: centrally located, fair prices and small enough to keep track of everyone.

Christmas in the City & Region

Insider tip: wander from one Christmas market to the next, listen to the “Singing Christmas Tree” and go ice skating in front of the Opera House.

60 Wienachtdorf
One of the largest Christmas markets is held at Sechseläutenplatz. Local designers offer jewelry and unusual finds. There's also a choice of culinary delights.



61 Christkindlimarkt at Zurich Main Station
Zurich's most central Christmas market takes place in the Main Station. Featuring 140 stalls, it is one of the largest indoor Christmas markets in Europe.



62 Singing Christmas Tree
Arranged in rows on a vertical podium in the shape of a Christmas tree, various children's choirs spread Christmas cheer with their carols.



63 Märli tram by Jelmoli
The historic tram built in 1913 has chauffeured nearly 10,000 children through Zurich every Christmas since 1958. During the trip, angels tell Christmas stories.



64 Lucy Christmas Lights
During Advent, the famous Bahnhofstrasse shines more brightly than ever. For then, “Lucy” – as the Christmas lights are called – is switched on daily at nightfall.



65 Illuminarium
This light show transforms the Swiss National Museum's courtyard into an illuminated winter wonderland, featuring optical illusions and music.



66 Circus Conelli
Zurich's traditional Christmas Circus has been a firm part of the festive season in Zurich since 1992, bridging the gap between classic and contemporary circus arts.



67 Christmas Market Niederdorf
Zurich's oldest Christmas market is a tiny world of its own, located in the heart of the Old Town. It is one of the city's most romantic markets.



68 Christmas Market Münsterhof
At Zurich's newest Christmas market, the focus is on local businesses and products. It also offers workshops and hosts events.



69 Christmas Market Rapperswil
The market below the castle in the Old Town is characterized by its picturesque medieval setting and is one of the largest in Switzerland.



70 Christmas Market Winterthur
Follow the scent to the Christmas market in the picturesque Old Town, where 100 chalets try to outshine each other with their festive decorations.

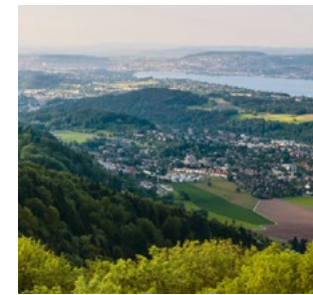


71 Christmas Market Einsiedeln
Set against the imposing backdrop of the Benedictine monastery and along the main street, the Christmas market in Einsiedeln is worth a visit.

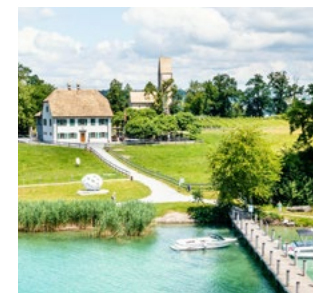

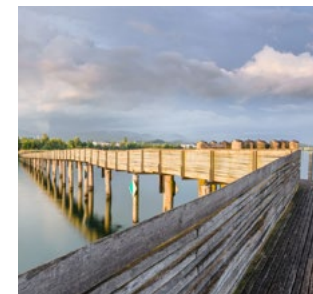

72 Uetliberg Felsenegg “Planet Path” Hike
There’s plenty to discover on this two-hour walk from Uetliberg to Felsenegg. The “Planet Path” takes you on a tour through our solar system with views over the lake and the city.



74 Ufenau Island
Combine a visit to the picturesque island with a boat cruise on Lake Zurich. With a cozy restaurant on the island, it’s the perfect place to kick back and relax.



76 Wooden Bridge, Rapperswil-Hurden
The wooden walkway is part of the Way of St. James to Santiago de Compostela. At 841m (2760 ft), it is the longest wooden bridge in Switzerland.



78 Monastery & Abbey, Einsiedeln
The magnificent Baroque construction of the monastery and the Lady Chapel (with Black Madonna) are the most popular attractions in Einsiedeln.



80 Zug Old Town
Zug’s exceptionally pretty Old Town, with its beautifully renovated buildings, lies directly on Lake Zug and bears witness to the town’s noble past. The Zugerberg is worth a visit in any season.



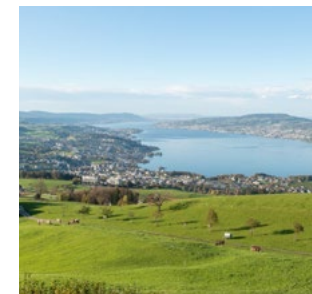
82 Mt. Titlis
The 3,020 m (9,908 ft) high Mt. Titlis is one of the most popular excursion destinations in Central Switzerland. From Zurich, the famous Mt. Titlis can be reached in under two hours.



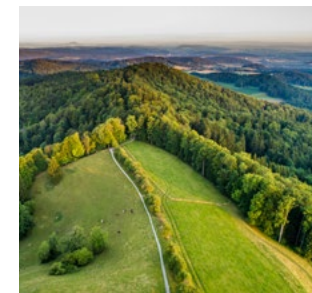
73 Rhine Falls & Laufen Castle
A magnificent spectacle: across a width of 150 m (492 ft) and a height of 23 m (75.5 ft), enormous amounts of water plunge down Europe’s largest waterfall.



75 Rapperswil Old Town & Castle
A small and picturesque town from the Middle Ages awaits you: cozy restaurants, a castle, busy streets, beautiful rose gardens and a lakeside promenade.



77 Lake Zurich Circular Hiking Tour
The Lake Zurich trail in its ten sections shows the region at its best, passing historic villages, unspoilt shorelines, extensive woods and wild, gushing streams.



79 Zurich Oberland
This rural area of Zurich is best enjoyed on foot on flat and slightly hilly paths with panoramic views, passing lakes and forests.



81 Mt. Rigi
The enchanting mountain in Central Switzerland is known as the “Queen of the Mountains” – and anyone who has visited Rigi understands why: it is surrounded by a breathtaking panorama.



83 Stoos-Fronalpstock
Down below, the lakes glisten, and even the history-steeped Rütli meadow, the birthplace of Switzerland, can be seen from here. The world’s steepest funicular railway can be experienced here.

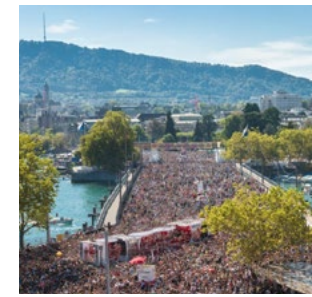

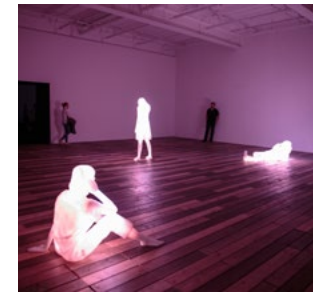

Every April, the Zurich Guilds celebrate spring with an annual procession featuring 3,500 guild members, 350 riders, 50 carriages and 30 brass bands.



Street Parade
The Street Parade sparks an incredible party atmosphere with 30 love mobiles, hundreds of DJs and seven stages around the Lake Zurich basin. It is the largest techno party in the world.



Zurich Art Weekend
One week before Art Basel opens its doors, Zurich turns into the hot-spot for international art enthusiasts. This means three days of exhibitions, guided tours, and lectures in hip venues.



Zurich Film Festival
The Zurich Film Festival gives its large audience an inside look into the work of up-and-coming filmmakers from around the world and awards the coveted "Golden Eye".



Weltklasse Zürich
Olympic gold medalists and world record holders gather at this international athletics meeting to provide spectators with sports at their highest level of performance.
