On may 21, 1871, Europe`s first mountain railway departed on its inaugural ascent from Vitznau to Rigi Staffelhöhe - a milestone in history of Mount Rigi. Today, Mount Rigi and its cogwheel railways and aerial cable cars mean heaven to mountain railways aficionados.

Short Stopover at Rigi Kulm



Rising to 1797 meters above sea level, Rigi Kulm is the highest peak of Mount Rigi. From here, you can enjoy a view of no fewer than 13 lakes and a regular “sea of peaks”, a 360-degree panorama that is truly the stuff of legend.

This pretty holiday resort at the south-west foot of the Rigi dips its toes in the clear waters of Lake Lucerne and consists of several municipal areas. It lies between alt. 434 m (surface of Lake Lucerne) and alt. 1659 m (Rotstock Rigi Kaltbad). The sunny promontory has long been a place where life is considered good. As Weggis is protected from cold northern winds, its mild climate allows Mediterranean plants such as palm trees, chestnuts and orchids to thrive.

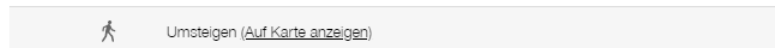
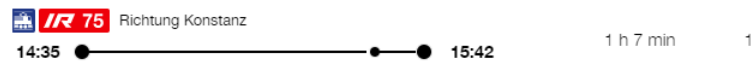

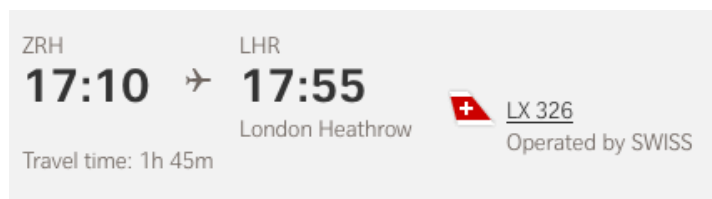

Practical Information

- Please do have a look at the Swiss weather forecast site before you pack:

- Switzerland is one hour ahead of the UK.
- What is included? The trip is all-inclusive of return flights, transfers, meals, and activities as listed in the programme.



- What is not included: personal expenses, mini-bar, telephones, drinks outside the programme, etc.
- Money: The exchange rate is currently around CHF 1.26 to the Pound Sterling, and the currency is Swiss Francs. Euros are only accepted in some places (main cities), but it is advisable to bring Swiss Francs. The trip is all-inclusive but you may wish to take some cash for personal expenses. Exchange can be done at the airport. ATM cash points in Switzerland also take most cards and give you a better rate of exchange.
- Travel Insurance: Travel insurance is not included and all medical and dental treatment in Switzerland is private and expensive. Please ensure that you take out a travel insurance. This insurance should cover you for any accidents, any medical treatment as well as loss of luggage and money. It is also highly recommendable that you apply for a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), which has replaced the old E111 form. For more information, please visit:

Dress code: casual with something smart for the evenings. Please make sure to bring warm clothes (layers). We will be in the mountains and it will be cold during this time of the year.

- Warm clothes according to prevailing weather conditions
- Ski clothing and helmet
