The latest announcement by the Swiss government included a reference to the complete freedom to travel within the Schengen area by 6 July at the latest. We are currently waiting for the information as to when the Swiss borders will open to travelers from non-Schengen countries and are keeping updated on the British & Irish quarantine.

SWISS started to gradually expand their flight schedule from June. Travellers will continue to benefit from their flexible rebooking options. SWISS has been operating a daily flight between Zurich and London throughout the lockdown period. This is now increased to 11 flights a week between Zurich or Geneva to London. In addition, SWISS will operate one weekly flight between Zurich and Edinburgh and up to 4 flights between Zurich and Dublin.
