Switzerland's regulations.

Updated: 25.08.2020

 <p>Open for Tourism</p> <p>Switzerland welcomes UK and Irish citizens as well as residents of most <u>EU/EFTA countries and selected third countries</u> without restrictions.</p>	 <p>Clean and Safe</p> <p>Our "clean and safe" label allows our Swiss suppliers to certify their efforts of guaranteeing the security and cleanliness measures following the official protocols.</p>	 <p>Masks</p> <p>Masks are mandatory when using the public transport (train, tram, bus and boat) in Switzerland. In some cantons masks have to be worn in shops as well.</p>
 <p>Health</p> <p>Check the <u>official recommendations</u> and <u>security guidelines</u> when travelling to Switzerland. Make sure that you have a valid travel insurance.</p>	 <p>Hotels and Restaurants</p> <p>All hotels and restaurants are open and follow the official protection protocols. These include distance between tables and customers contact details being requested.</p>	 <p>Public Transport</p> <p>The <u>public transport operates regularly with social distancing guidelines</u> in place. It is mandatory to wear a face mask when using public transport.</p>
 <p>Mountain railways and panoramic trains.</p> <p>Mountain railways and panoramic trains are running on a mostly normal schedule. They follow their specific security guidelines.</p>	 <p>Other touristic sites</p> <p>Museums, cinemas, theatres, botanical gardens, and wellness places are open and apply security guidelines. 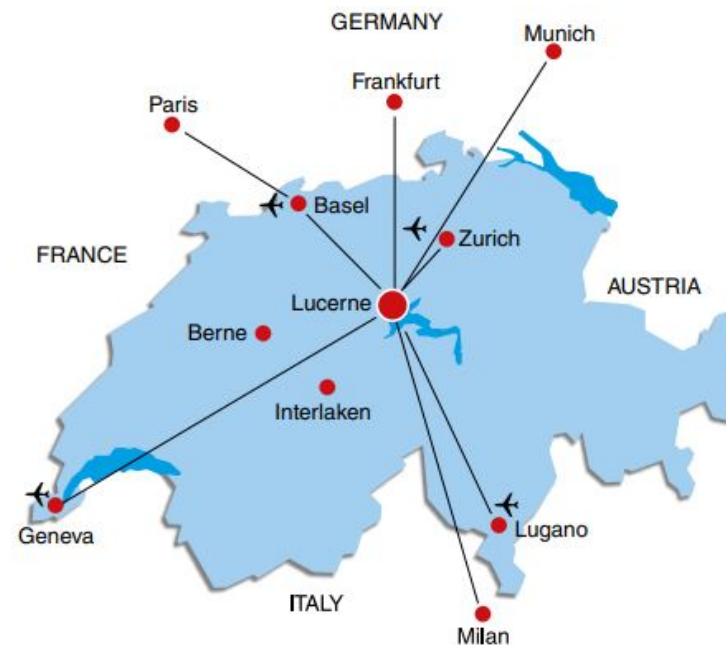
