Nendaz: a family-friendly resort

Nendaz will delight families as well as powder seekers. Those looking for gentle runs will undoubtedly love the resort's three beginners' areas. Tracouet beginners' park, named after the frozen lake that surrounds it, offers a unique playground where children can securely enjoy their first experience in the snow with a magic carpet, beginners' and baby lifts and a snowtubing area. Parents can supervise little ones while unwinding over drinks and snacks in Lake Bar, just a few metres away.



Freedom for freeriders

Experienced skiers and snowboarders can explore the region in comfort and style, as it has more secure freeride zones than anywhere else. From the legendary Plan du Fou, Gentianes and Chassoure to the epic Mont Gelé, Vallon d'Arbi and Col des Mines, you'll want to try them all to see which one will remain engraved in your memory forever.

Mont Fort

If there is one thing you can't miss during your stay in Nendaz, it's Mont Fort. At 3,300m, it is the highest summit in the Four Valleys, and easily reached by cable car.

From the top, a new panoramic platform offers sweeping views of the Alps' best known peaks such as Mont Blanc, Matterhorn and Grand Combin

Adrenaline-seekers will also want to try Mont4Zipline – the world's highest zipline – which whizzes down Mont Fort. The 1.4km trail flies you over the Tortin Glacier at more than 100km per hour. Advanced skiers and snowboarders can also tackle the Mont Fort ski slope, one of the steepest in the Alps.


