The Grand Train Tour of Switzerland...




- combines the most beautiful train lines in Switzerland into one route

Good to know

- Interlaken Ost–Luzern: Hourly from 07.04 h to 20.04 h
- Luzern–Interlaken Ost: Hourly from 06.06 h to 21.06 h
- "Bistro Order" App: conveniently order drinks and snacks from the seat
- "LiveGuide" App: The app provides plenty of interesting information about the highlights of the region and indicates the train's current position on a virtual map
- Seat reservation recommended but not required; reservation fee per person and direction:
 - 15 Dec 2019–15 May 2020 & 02 Nov–31 Dec 2020 CHF 10
 - 16 May–01 Nov 2020 CHF 14

Vigezzina-Centovalli.



- Valid travel documents required for border crossing into Italy
- The Vigezzina-Centovalli Railway operates almost every two hours
- On the panoramic trains, a seat surcharge applies for the Italian section (Domodossola–Camedo). For groups, seat reservations are required for the whole section
- The surcharge EUR 1.50 is payable on board






