


UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site

- Founded by the monk Gallus in 612
- Cathedral was built from 1755 to 1767
- The Abbey Library counts 170,000 books and over 2,000 original handwritings
- Abbey District is a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site since 1983

Perfect hub between a lake and the mountains

- Short distances between the mountains and the Lake Constance.
 - 20 min from St.Gallen to the Lake Constance
 - 45 min from St.Gallen to the Mount Säntis
- Since St.Gallen-Bodensee has mountains, a lake and is located in the corner of four countries, it is also known as the little Switzerland within Switzerland.





Culinary diversity

- St.Gallen is known for its 4 B's:
 - 1. Bratwurst (sausage)
 - 2. Biber (a sweet pastry)
 - 3. Bier (beer)
 - 4. Bürli (bread we eat with sausage).
- Olma Bratwurst is Switzerland's best sausage and we eat it WITHOUT mustard.
- Focus on local products



Bermuda triangle & bar scene

- Bermuda Triangle: More than 20 bars are located in the northern old town of St.Gallen. It may happen to get lost in the Bermuda triangle – take care!
- Tiki Strandbar: Beach feeling on the lakeside of Lake Constance.
- Südbar: Beers and cocktails combined with cultural activities, comedy and concerts.




Red Square





